## **2022 RECAP & 2023 INFORMATION**

### **NO DUE'S INCREASES FOR 2023!**

**FOR THE 3<sup>RD</sup> YEAR IN A ROW, THE LFSC BOARD VOTED NOT TO INCREASE DUE'S FOR 2023.  
(SEE RENEWAL FORM FOR AMOUNTS & MEMBERSHIP OPTIONS)**

Renewals submitted by mail **MUST** be postmarked no later than December 31, 2022. If postmarked after December 31, 2022, the renewal will be returned. If placed in the DropBox, mark the name and drop date on the envelope. Renewals picked up after December 31, 2022, will be returned. Renewals may be given to the Membership Secretary at the October, November, or December business meetings.

**PLEASE NOTE: If you presently have, or are eligible for a Senior discount in 2023, but fail to renew by the due date, and subsequently rejoin, you won't be eligible for a Senior discount. The Senior discount has been eliminated for 2023 new members and thereafter.**

Your renewal form contains primary member information: name, address, home number, mobile number, member number, and email address. Please verify the information is correct and complete the remaining items on the form. Make sure to sign your renewal form. Unsigned forms will be returned. An important question is answered by signing your form.

#### **THE FOLLOWING MAJOR IMPROVEMENTS, REPAIRS, AND PURCHASES WERE MADE IN 2022:**

1. The clubhouse boiler had to be replaced.
2. LED fixtures replaced the outdated and problematic lights in the Clubhouse, Indoor Range, and Snack Shack.
3. Upgraded 50 Yd. and John Wayne ranges pavilion floors to concrete.
4. Engineered and made hangar system for rubber ricochet barriers in Indoor Range. This was done to allow easier access to backstop for cleaning and repairs.
5. Extended roadway paving from the Steel Plate Range to the 100 Yd. Range and Rental Range parking areas.
6. Widened pavement at gate area to create a Waiting Area for Guests, etc. that don't have access to the club.
7. Paved 300 Yd. Range roadway and created turnaround areas.
8. Purchased snow plow accessory for Track Steer.

**TOTAL 2022 ANNUALIZED EXPENSES ARE: \$153,500**

**BELOW ARE ANNUALIZED MAJOR EXPENSE CATEGORIES INCURRED IN 2022:**

**Maintenance & Improvements: \$108,969 Insurance: \$11,300 Utilities: \$11,500 Taxes: \$5,719**

**Equipment & Maintenance: \$8,210 Membership Expense (Renewals & New Members): \$2,663 Indoor Range: \$3,442**

As you can see, it's very expensive to maintain and manage our club, and more expensive every year! However, the LFSC Board and Members have made sound spending decisions to continue improving our club, and keep membership costs at a very reasonable amount.
